Review and approve Annual Town Meeting Warrant

Mr. Sieloff presented the Board with a proposed Annual Town Meeting Warrant for their review. Mr. Sieloff stated that the Town is still waiting to hear about a grant for the Fire truck in Article 12. Mr. Sieloff stated that he spoke with the Fire Chief who stated that the Town may not hear anything until the end of October. Mr. Goerlach asked if the Town could use next year's Baker Hill allotment of \$50,000 to decrease the amount to be borrowed. Mr. Sieloff stated that they could. In Article 17 Mr. Goerlach and Mr. Sayers asked Mr. Sieloff to remove the brand Bobcat and just use the term skid-steer. Mr. Sieloff stated Article 26 was added relative to towing. Mr. Sieloff stated that he had spoken to Acting Chief Sorrell and he stated that the Police Department does not currently have the authority to tow vehicles. Motion 15-73. Motion made by Henry Sayers to authorize the Annual Town Meeting Warrant with changes to Article 17, seconded by John Goerlach. Unanimously voted. Mr. Sayers voted on Article 26 relative to towing out of the rule of necessity.

Other business which could not have been reasonably foreseen within 48 hours of the meeting.

Mr. Sieloff presented the Board with a proposed contract for Pittsfield Community Television (PCTV) for their review. Mr. Sieloff stated that the current PCTV contract expires at the end of May and this will renew it until August 31, 2015. Motion 15-74. Motion made by Henry Sayers to approve the contract of PCTV until 8/31/15, seconded by John Goerlach. Unanimously voted.
