

**Lanesborough Board of Health
Minutes for Meeting May 2, 2011**

In Attendance: May Hickey, Francisca Heming, Nancy Boudreau, Ed Fahey
Issues raised:

1. **Approval of Minutes:** April 4, 2011 meeting.
2. **Tobacco collaboration with Tri-Town Health** discussion.
3. **E-Cigarettes:** Will continue to research.
4. **Trash Haulers:** LBOH will receive a yearly report from each Hauler that will include; number of customers, total tonnage, tonnage of recycled
5. **Berkshire VNA:** Lanesborough will arrange a meeting.
6. **Beaudoin Mototrack:** \$5,000 was received 2 weeks late and the Judge ruled that an additional fine be imposed. The judge also ruled that the sound testing must be completed and that the parties agree on the scope and cost of a plan. The Judge also ruled that if the defendants fail to meet future deadlines that a warrant for their arrest would be issued
7. **Complaint of smoke from Arizona Pizza:** The complainant is over 1,000feet away. The owner will inquire about ways to reduce smoke.
8. **Camp Mohawk.** The State is waiting for more documents. BOH provide the camp with information about CORY and SORY classes
9. **Enviro Lab:** Bill from 2009, OK to pay
10. **Emergency Distribution Site Plan:** Lanesborough has received a \$2,500 grant to set up and EDS plan.
11. **Regionalization Community:** Moving forward with a new agreement for towns to sign.
12. **Greylock Estates:** Title V inspection, awaiting DEP ruling.

13. Health Agent Issues:

- a. 18 Baglee Ave. Septic plans approval pending the plans to include old septic system
- b. 6 Glens Rd. Septic plans approval pending the plans to include old septic system
- c. Partridge Rd., Minneci: Plans cleared Con Com. Septic Plan approved
- d. Szczepaniak: Not compliant with Tobacco permitting, letter sent giving him 2 more weeks to comply. If he remains non-compliant he will no longer be able to sell tobacco products.
- e. Bradlee Farm. Must have both a retail and residential permit by the end of May or he will be unable to sell food.
- f. Reminder to be sent to food establishments to be compliant with allergen program. Informed that a \$50 late fee will be implemented for non-compliance, also after 2weeks their permit to operate will be revoked.
