### Proposed Chicken Regulations

Mr. Marvin Michalak and Ms. Darlene Newton requested BOH draft regulations as to how many fowl can be kept on a property based on size of lot(s). They presented several regulations/guidelines from other towns as a guideline for BOH to draft regulations for the Town of Lanesborough, MA. Mr. Michalak requested we have an easy to reference chart with the number of fowl allowed per square foot/acreage. Ms. Heming suggested we look into the provided regulations/guidelines and further review and our next meeting.

### Jeff Wilbur

### Animal Inspector Nomination

### Bouncy House at Berkshire Mall

Mr. Ed Fahey spoke with the Manager of the Berkshire Mall and was assured the sewage leak was cleaned, sanitized, and the leak fixed to avoid further issues. Mr. Fahey will send a letter to the Manager with a synopsis of the situation and the resulting conversation.

### Greylock Estates Septic System Inspections

Mr. Fahey received a letter dated March 7 from Greylock Estates indicating they are in agreement with the BOH request to have the Association's shared septic disposal field (including the pump chambers, holding tanks, distribution boxes, etc.) inspected every three years by a licenses Title 5 inspector. The letter also requested the inspection on June 19, 2015 be considered the first in the ongoing three-year cycle. Mr. Fahey sent a letter dated March 16 to Ms. Julianne Maxwell, Director that BOH is in agreement with Greylock Estates requests.

### Body Art Regulations

The Body Art Regulations 2016-001 as well as the Application for Permit were approved by the Board as of March 14, 2016. Ms. Thompson will notify Crazy Chameleon the regs and application are available.

### 34 Lacona St. Septic Plan

The septic plans were approved and signed.
