PERMIT PROCEDURE FOR OUTDOOR WOOD-BURNING BOILERS

1. Applicant obtains permit application from Board of Health.
2. Applicant returns completed application with fee payment, a plot plan with location of OWB, including setbacks, sets an appointment with the Health Agent to confirm setbacks. Permit will be issued after this visit.
3. On completion of installation, applicant will supply a letter to the BOH, stating that the OWB has been installed according to the manufacturer's instructions. The Health Agent will revisit the site for a final inspection to recheck setbacks and verify presence of a spark arrestor.
