Re: Recommendation for Lanesborough Part-time Police Officers

Selectmen,

On July 21, Chief Tim Sorrell and all 5 members of the Lanesborough Police Advisory Commission interviewed 5 candidates for employment with the Lanesborough PD. These positions are for part-time work at this time. The five candidates were Lucas A. Perry, Kevin J. Stant, David S. Hill, Christopher R. Lampiasi, and Cody R. Alvarez. All five men are fully trained for part-time police work, and possess varying degrees of experience. All five candidates interviewed quite well, but two were clearly better candidates than the others.

**Lucas A. Perry**

Lucas is a graduate of St. Joseph High School, Massachusetts Firefighting Academy, and Berkshire Law Enforcement Council Reserve/Intermittent Academy (2015), and is currently studying at BCC for Criminal Justice. Lucas is currently employed as a full-time firefighter/EMT with the town of Dalton and an instructor for the Massachusetts Fire Academy. He also works as a part-time Police officer in the town of Egremont and as an EMT for County Ambulance Service in Pittsfield. His training and certifications also include CPR/AED, National Incident Management System (NIMS), Certified Scuba Diver, Rapid Intervention Team, and several areas with the Municipal Police Training Council. Lucas, although young in age, has an abundance of experience in his young career.

**David S. Hill**

David has done it all. He was a Federal Law Enforcement Officer, and Counter-Terrorism/Drug Interdiction Officer with the Department of Homeland Security. He also served with the U.S. Coast Guard in the roles of Instructor/Pilot, Special Missions instructor, Aviation and Ground Safety

officer, and as a legal officer. He has a BS in Criminal Justice, and is a flight examiner. He has served in Bosnia, Kosovo, Albania, Liberia, Central African Republic, Somalia, and Gulf Wars. He is presently employed with the Department of Defense as a QA specialist, and spends time as a commercial pilot for single-engine planes and helicopters. He is a career military officer, and can bring us personal experience, strong leadership skills, common sense, fair judgement, tact and maturity. David is not seeking employment for financial reasons, but rather for a desire to continue serving the public. He strongly believes in community policing and possesses a strong need to serve and protect the public.

Lucas A. Perry is a young, eager, trainable and personable young man. He is eager to learn. David S. Hill is mature, articulate, and ready for work. Both men are highly recommended by the Lanesborough Police Advisory Commission for appointment to the positions of part-time officers for the town of Lanesborough.


